

Ontario Grant to Support Anti-Hate Security Measures for Faith-Based and Cultural Organizations

A \$25-million program that will provide funds to faith-based and cultural organizations to increase safety and security measures against hate-related incidents

Who is eligible?

- The organization must be a registered charity or a not-for-profit corporation that owns, leases or rents an indoor facility in Ontario that is used for regular gatherings of religious, spiritual or cultural significance at least once a month.
- Organizations are required to attest that they will use the entirety of the grant on one or more of the eligible expenses to protect their communities and facilities against hate incidents.

How can my organization apply?

- Applications for the grant must be submitted on or before **March 3, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. EST.**

How much funding could my organization receive?

- Eligible organizations may receive a one-time grant of \$5,000, \$7,500 or \$10,000 based on the organization's 2019 revenue.
