**Subject: Reminder Letter for
Canadian Mennonite Publishing Service (the Organization)**

Dear Mr. Benner:

As you know, along with the many advantages and privileges of being a registered charity in Canada come a number of obligations under the *Income Tax Act*, its *Regulations* and the common law. We are writing at this time to remind you of the limitations imposed on registered charities in regards to partisan political activities under subsections 149.1(6.1) and (6.2) of the Act.

Registered charities must comply with the rules and *Regulations* set out in the *Income Tax Act* and its *Regulations*. The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) regulates registered charities and is committed to ensuring that charities operate in compliance with the law.

It has come to our attention that recent issues of the Organization's monthly periodical, entitled "Canadian Mennonite", have contained editorials and/or articles that appear to promote opposition to a political party, or to candidates for public office.

Under the Act, charities are allowed to engage in some political activities, but are prohibited from engaging in partisan political activities. Such partisan activities involve the "*direct or indirect support of, or opposition to, any political party or candidate for public office*". Registered charities that engage in partisan political activities jeopardize their charitable status and can be subject to revocation. However, in this circumstance we felt a reminder letter was in order.

We hope the information provided will serve to clarify the rules under which charities agree to operate when they are granted charitable status. We trust that the Organization will take appropriate action to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act.
