



Canadian charities giving to Indigenous Charities and Qualified Donees - 2019

On May 31, 2021 we published an article [Canadian charities giving to Indigenous Charities and Qualified Donees – 2018](#) (“2018 Article”) which discussed the gifts by all Canadian charities to Indigenous Charities.

The 2018 Article noted in summary:

It appears there were 284 grants to Indigenous Groups out of 28,164 that were over \$30,000. So just over 1% of grants were to Indigenous Groups. There were 7 gifts of \$1 million and over to Indigenous groups. 117 gifts over \$100,000 in total. The total amount given by Canadian charities (including charitable organizations, public foundations and private foundations) to Indigenous Groups was \$46,887,535.

In 2018 Canadian charities gave to other charities and qualified donees \$9,400,321,633 which is slightly over \$9.4 billion. Of the total grants over \$30,000 given by registered charities they were \$8,350,587,042 in value which is about 89% of the dollars involved.

How much does the \$46,887,535 equate to as a percentage of the \$8.3 billion? As a percentage Indigenous groups received 0.005614879%. This is about $\frac{1}{2}$ a percent of the funds granted.

Even though Indigenous people are about 4.9% of the population, Indigenous Groups received just over one half a percent of gifted funds. As Indigenous people account for 4.9% of the Canadian population then Indigenous groups are receiving about 1/10th of the funding that they would receive as a result of population size, even if one ignores issues of need. Indigenous Groups are getting about \$1 for every \$178 given to non-Indigenous groups.

We thought that it might be useful to update the 2018 Article and provide a note on 2019 gifts.

We recently reviewed the T3010 Registered Charity Information Return database for 2019 to see how many gifts and the value of those gifts were made from Canadian registered charities to “Indigenous Charities” and certain Qualified Donees such as First Nation Governments or ‘Bands’ (listed as “[municipal or public body performing a function of government in Canada](#)”). Together we refer to them as “Indigenous Groups”.

To identify Indigenous Groups, we reviewed the list with all grants over \$30,000 and we also used terms and phrases such as: Indigenous, First Nation, Metis, Inuit, Indian, Indian Band, Nation, Tribal council, National Indian Brotherhood, etc.. We also used a list from the [Indigenous Peoples Solidarity Fund by CanadaHelps](#) developed by Wanda Brascoupe. We cut off the review at \$30,000 because these larger grants are over 28,000 grants and also encompass about 90% of the value of grants made by Canadian charities to qualified donees. If an individual or corporation donates to an Indigenous Group, this would not be reflected in this article as we only have visibility as to registered charities making gifts to other qualified donees.

We encourage others to either do a more comprehensive review or use a different methodology.

We believe that Indigenous led charities are vital in providing culturally appropriate services. There are numerous charities in Canada that are either Indigenous led or primarily serving Indigenous communities, but it is not always easily determinable who they are and how many there are. These groups include First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples. There are many misconceptions about the funding of Indigenous Groups, and we are trying to add a little bit to the understanding of how these groups are funded. Below we provide the 2019 statistics with 2018 in brackets for comparison.

It appears that in 2019 there were 376 (284) grants to Indigenous Groups out of 29,045 (28,164) that were over \$30,000. So just under 1.3% (just over 1%) of grants were to Indigenous Groups. There were 9 (7) gifts of \$1 million and over to Indigenous groups. 156 (117) gifts over \$100,000 in total. The total amount given by Canadian charities (including charitable organizations, public foundations and private foundations) to Indigenous Groups was \$60,568,555. (\$46,887,535).

In 2019 Canadian charities gave to other charities and qualified donees \$9,657,526,922 (\$9,400,321,633) which is slightly over \$9.6 billion (\$9.4 billion). Of the total grants over \$30,000 given by registered charities they were \$8,409,716,653 (\$8,350,587,042) in value which is about 87% of the dollars involved.

How much does the \$60,568,555 (\$46,887,535) equate to as a percentage of the \$8.4 billion (\$8.3 billion)? As a percentage Indigenous groups received 0.0072022114 (0.005614879%). This is about .7 percent (one half a percent) of the funds granted.

Even though Indigenous people are about 4.9% of the population, Indigenous Groups received just over .7 percent (one half a percent) of gifted funds. As Indigenous people account for 4.9% of the Canadian population then Indigenous groups are receiving about 1/7th (1/10th) of the funding that they would receive as a result of population size, even if one ignores issues of need. Indigenous Groups are getting about \$1 for every \$138 (\$178) given to non-Indigenous groups.

This reflects a similar finding in a recent report released in December 2020, '[The Charity Report reveals where private foundations spend their money](#)', that reviewed the funding of 20 private foundations that gave a total of \$1.63 billion in grants, in which 0.2% of funding went to support Indigenous organizations.

Just to put these total numbers in context, there are 9 (11) non-Indigenous charities that each received more than all the Indigenous Groups in Canada combined in 2019. As well, Brigham Young University, a foreign registered university and therefore a qualified donee received about \$76 million (\$73 million) in that same year from Canadian charities. So, one foreign university received more funds from Canadian charities than all Indigenous Groups in Canada.

As the data demonstrates, there has been little improvement in charitable grants to Indigenous Groups in 2019 compared to the previous 2018 data. While there is a growing awareness of how wealth has been accumulated in Canada through the dispossession of land, agriculture production, and the extraction of natural resources, much more needs to be done to foster equity and reconciliation.

For those who wish to make a donation to Indigenous Groups, one option is to use the [Indigenous Peoples Solidarity Fund by CanadaHelps](#) developed by Wanda Brascoupe. The Fund includes 57 Indigenous Groups, and your money will be allocated by CanadaHelps amongst those groups. Over \$1 million has been raised by CanadaHelps in that fund so far.

Furthermore, if you search the word Indigenous on [CharityData.ca](#) you will see almost 500 groups have the word Indigenous in their name or their program description. Also, there are 289 that have [First Nations](#) in their name or program description. On each page of the CharityData.ca website at the bottom is a link to the CanadaHelps profile as well as the CRA's Charities Listing to confirm that the group is still a registered charity. There is no shortage of Indigenous registered charities and qualified donees. Additionally, on page 23 of this article, there is a listing of Municipal and public bodies performing a function of government which includes about 500 Indigenous bands.

Below is the list of grants over \$30,000 to Indigenous Groups in Canada from other Canadian charities in 2019. The data has been collected from the T3010 filings of registered charities.

Please review the caveats found on pages 21 and 22 below concerning the reliability and usage of the T3010 information.

Limitations and Caveats

There are a number of cautions in dealing with the information from the T3010. You can access the CRA Charities Listing database directly on the CRA website at: <https://www.canada.ca/en/revenue-agency/services/charities-giving/charities.html>. As well, Blumbergs also maintains Canada's largest charity information portal at www.CharityData.ca with up to 19 years of information on every Canadian registered charity. The portal is free and the aim is to increase transparency in the Canadian charity sector. With CRA removing recently over 10 years' worth of information from the Charities Listing, www.CharityData.ca has far more years available.

- 1) The data in this note is based on the 2019 T3010 Registered Charity Information Return filings. Although all charities are supposed to file their T3010 within 6 months of their fiscal year end, some charities file late or do not file at all and then will lose their charitable status. Depending on the data set from CRA, not every charity may have filed their T3010 or been inputted yet.
- 2) Registered charities complete the T3010 and one person signs the form. The T3010 information is not independently verified by CRA when it is posted on the CRA site or placed in the CRA database.
- 3) Although an important legal document, the T3010 is often completed by volunteers or others who may have little understanding of the nuances of the *Income Tax Act* (Canada), limited language skills, may not have easy access to the correct information or are in a hurry to file the form to avoid deregistration. In the case of larger institutions, it is typically accountants or finance staff who prepare the T3010. One would expect greater accuracy with the larger institutions. However, as they also tend to be more complicated and involve bigger numbers, the likelihood of a significant inaccuracy in their T3010 filings is great.
- 4) The T3010s are filed with CRA and in many cases needs to be coded by hand at CRA which can also introduce mistakes. Only a small number of T3010s have 2D bar code technology which can eliminate most processing errors on CRA's part. Canadian charities can as of June 2019 electronically file the T3010 under the CRA's Charities My Business Account) which will hopefully reduce errors and speeds up the process for T3010 data becoming available.
- 5) In some cases, those completing the T3010 for a charity are deliberately deceptive when completing the T3010. For example, an organization knows that it has substantial fundraising or political expenses but chooses to put them under charitable activities. Or an organization claims pharmaceuticals that it can purchase for \$50,000 are really worth \$50 million.
- 6) Don't rely on any of this information without checking with the charity and appropriate due diligence as required.

7) The T3010 is a tax form which is supposed to be completed according to guidance provided by the CRA in Guide Completing the Registered Charity Information Return (T-4033) and also various other CRA guidances and policies. The information inputted may not conform to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and often the numbers will not match what is in a financial statement. You can obtain copies of financial statements, whether audited or not, on any registered charity by requesting the financial statements from CRA. These financial statements are filed with CRA but not added to the CRA website and they can sometimes add further information.

8) Some questions on the T3010 are more prone to error than others because some questions are complicated, while others are quite straightforward. Some matters are easily quantifiable, like the value of official donation receipts, while others require allocation and other subjective measurements. Some questions, like revenue, are answered by almost every charity and if a charity makes a mistake, the likelihood is that such a mistake will not have much impact on the bigger picture.

9) The T3010 asks certain questions. Many important questions are not asked on the T3010. Relying on the T3010 to make decisions on whether a charity is efficient or worthwhile to support is prone to failure. Blumbergs has established a website www.smartgiving.ca which discusses in detail questions donors may want to ask before donating to charity.
