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1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) FIXED ASSETS

Fixed assets are expensed in the year of acquisition.

(b) INVENTORY

Inventory is stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value.

(c) BASIS OF RECORDING

All revenue and expenditures are recorded on an accrual basis.

(d) RECORDING OF INTEREST EARNED

Interest earned on term deposits and marketable securities is recorded in the Statement of Operations except for interest related to designated funds which is recorded directly in the Statement of Surplus. In 2021, the investments earned \$14,606 (2020 - \$31,536) of which \$14,606 (2020 - \$31,536) is allocated to revenue and \$nil (2020 - \$nil) is allocated to designated funds.

From time to time the Board may designate certain portions of the surplus available to be used for specific activities. Any expenditures made towards those specific activities are included in the Statement of Operations. Fund in lieu of pension was the only designated fund.

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4. MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE

2021 miscellaneous revenue is comprised of CEBA Loan forgiveness \$10,000, air travel refund \$713, credit card cash back \$823 and alumni donation \$500.

5. PURCHASE OF CONDOMINIUM

Little League Baseball Canada purchased an office condominium on March 14, 2017 for \$349,057. The purchase was recorded directly in the Statement of Operations in 2017.
