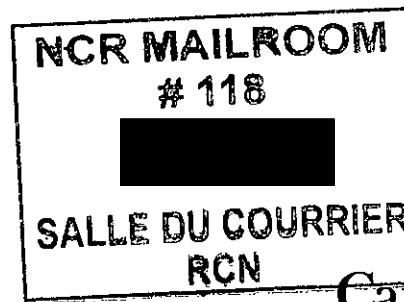

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Summary of Financial Position and Key Insights

Welcome to Quidditch Canada's annual report for 2019/2020. The purpose of the report is to provide insight into the financial position of Quidditch Canada for our Fiscal year beginning September 1, 2019 and ending August 31, 2020.

The 2019/2020 Fiscal year was an important year for Quidditch Canada, and its continued development of its financial policies. Some restructuring over the year due to COVID 19 and to our accounting systems have changed the way the organization will operate in the future.

COVID 19 Concerns

The 2019/2020 season was cut short due to COVID19. On March 11, the National Planning Committee in partnership with Quidditch Canada made the difficult decision to cancel Nationals 2020 due to safety concerns to members. This has had a substantial impact on our 2019/2020 Financial statements as Nationals is a large budget item. Quidditch Canada also made the difficult decision to suspend regular play in March due to COVID19, which reduced player numbers and revenue through Quarters 3 and 4 of our fiscal year.

Accounting Changes

In June of 2020, Quidditch Canada migrated all its financial records to the [REDACTED] platform. The overall of Quidditch Canada's financial operations will allow for more insightful records for the organization. This will also help resolve the issue of inaccurate reporting due to mismatched accounting and tracking systems.

Along with migration over to the [REDACTED] platform, Quidditch Canada has also created a standardized method of reporting. The attached financial statement outlines the accounts that will be used for all future financial statements. Note that any account with a \$0.00 value, is not shown for clarity purposes.

Along with Quidditch Canada's changes to its financial policy, statements for 2018/2019 and the 2019/2020 budget had to be amended to the new standard. This allows for a meaningful record to be established between the old accounting format and the new accounting format.

Key Findings

Quidditch Canada's financial performance over 2019/2020 resulted in a Net Profit of \$1,988.85 which is lower than the Net Profit in 2018/2019 of \$4,595.71. This can be attributed to the cancellation of the 2020 Nationals, and a reduction in the spring/summer 2020 Quidditch Season due to COVID19. Due to these external factors, Quidditch Canada's performance for the year, seems to be on par with previous year's spending.

Both Eastern and Western Regionals were able to reduce spending this year. This reduction in spending is primarily derived from a reduction in field bookings costs and a reduction in rental equipment. If this trend continues into 2020/2021, Quidditch Canada will be in a strong financial position for future years.

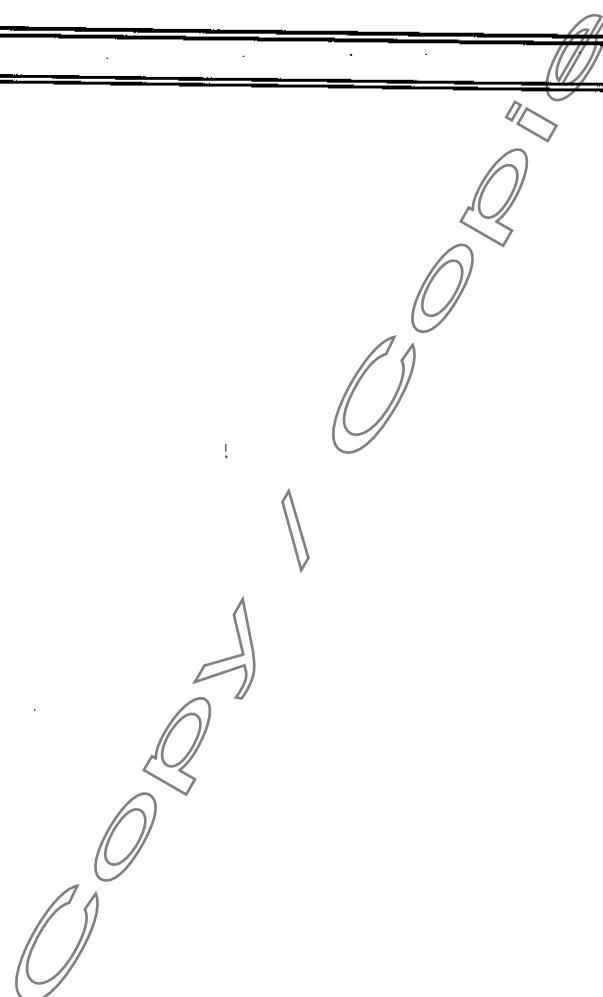
Quidditch Canada's Balance Sheet continues to remain strong, with \$52,592.10 in cash or cash equivalents. This showcases the organizations strong financial position in being able to invest into new opportunities for the sport as they arise.

Statement of Consolidated Income Commentary

1020 Event Fees

Represent the total revenue collected from events. Individual event income can be found in each event's breakdown, following the Statement of Financial Position.

1021 Nationals Fees

Is a breakdown of the Nationals event specifically. Note that fees were collected in 2019/2020 for the event, which were reimbursed in April. The outstanding balance on the account is due to 1 refund which was never deposited.

1030 Merchandise Sales

Merchandise sales is primarily tracked through the Square platform. Due to previous tracking metrics, our reporting on merchandise sales and expenses are not as detailed as they should be. Through [REDACTED] Quidditch Canada hopes to provide more insightful sales figures on future financial disclosures and created more detailed data on how merchandise is purchased.

1040 Team Canada Income

Due to the nature of Team Canada and their expenses, Team Canada has been allocated its own budgets lines under both income and expenses. Team Canada's financial position can also be seen broken down as a separate project item. Team Canada's income comes primarily from a 50/50 split of Merchandise Revenue and Practice Fees charged to players.

1052 Donations

During the summer of 2020, Quidditch Canada created a fundraiser to support the Black Lives Matter movement. The total amount raised was \$2,505.93. This amount is reflected as a donation for cash inflows. Of the amount collected, \$2,500 of this amount was matched by Quidditch Canada, creating a total amount of \$5,005.93 to be donated. See Liabilities for more information on the total amount.

1054 Government of Canada Deposits

This account is regarding any deposits received from the Government of Canada or the Canada Revenue Agency. The balance of this account comes from GST Refunds which took place in 2019/2020

2040 Purchases

All equipment purchased through purchases is deemed to have a usable value of 1 year. In 2019/2020 new equipment was purchased for both the Western and Eastern Regional events. This included some new cameras purchased in account 2042 AV Equipment, which were used at both Regional events.

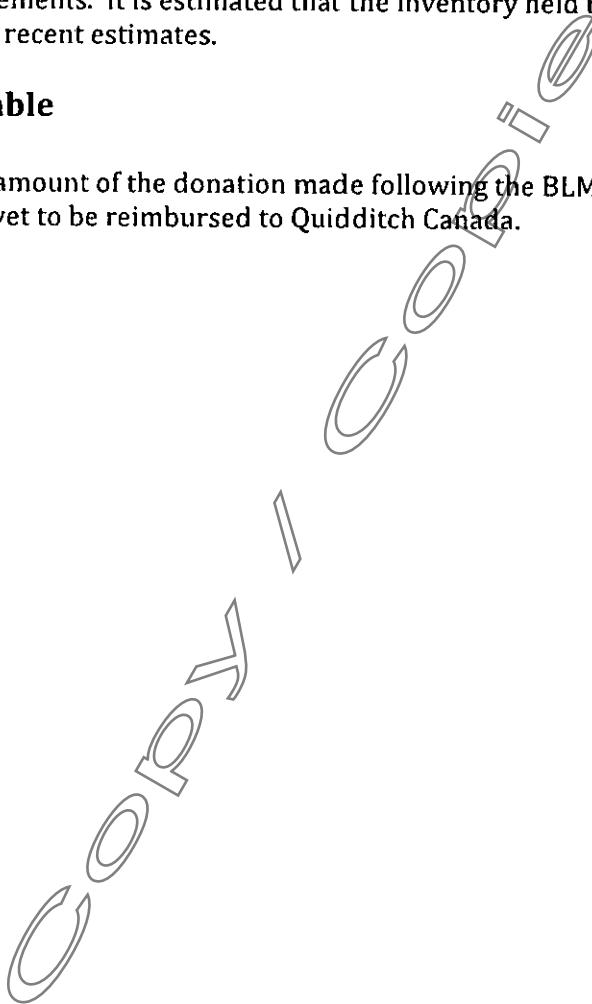
Most of Quidditch Canada's Assets reside as cash, in our General Bank account

As the amount of inventory is updated, the value will be corrected and totaled to reflect in the financial statements. It is estimated that the inventory held by Quidditch Canada totals \$2,000, based off the most recent estimates.

Original Budget & Adjusted Budget Changes

The original budget was originally prepared for the 2019/2020 season in September of 2019.

After moving to a new accounting system in the summer of 2020, the budget was imposed on the new reporting system for Quidditch Canada. Please note that the original budget amounts were used where possible, which resulted in some budgeting holes in the new system. The following budget items have been removed or adjusted in significant ways:

INCOME

Capital Development Fund (CDF) [\$2500] – was removed from the budget, as the process for setting up a fund is still under discussion by the board.

Event Revenue [\$1000] – Was removed due to it not fitting with the new budget breakdown. This category was being too broad.

EXPENSE

Topscore Fees [\$150] – has been reallocated to a Cost of Goods Sold (COGS) account due to the main revenue generation for Quidditch Canada being membership.

Error [\$250] – was removed, as a general budget should not have a budgeted line item for error.

Contracts and Consultants [\$2000] – This line item was removed as it doesn't fit with the new budget. These types of expenses would either be tracked in a specific event budget or in general administrative expenses depending on their use.

Equipment (storage, balls, etc.) [\$3000] – has been split into two accounts, Storage and Gameplay Equipment. This was done to provide a higher level of detail at the budget level for Quidditch Canada.

Moving forward, future budgets and subsequent statements will be prepared using the new accounting format. This will standardize the accounting process and allow for better financial analysis in future years.

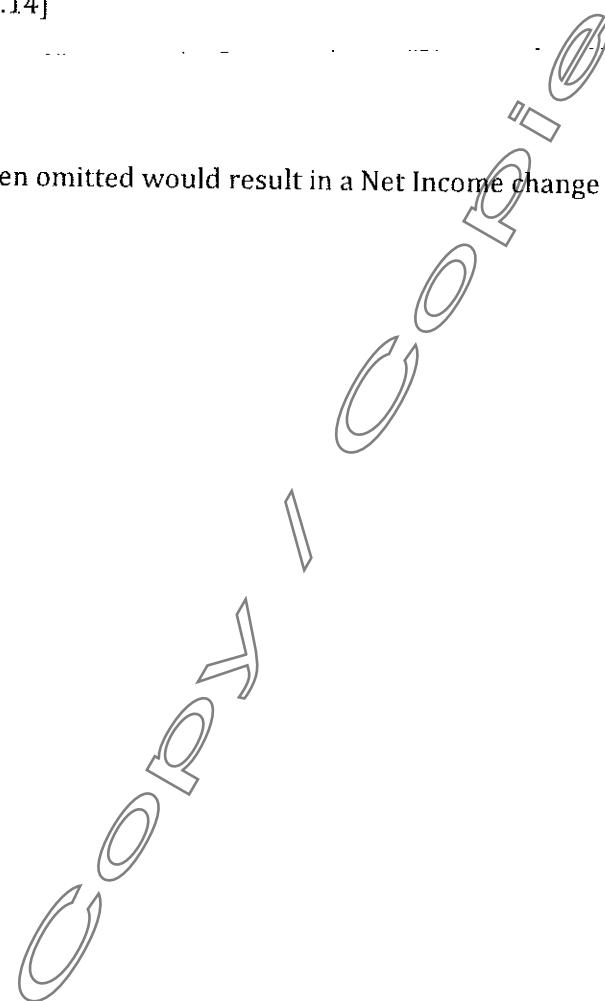

Closing Remarks

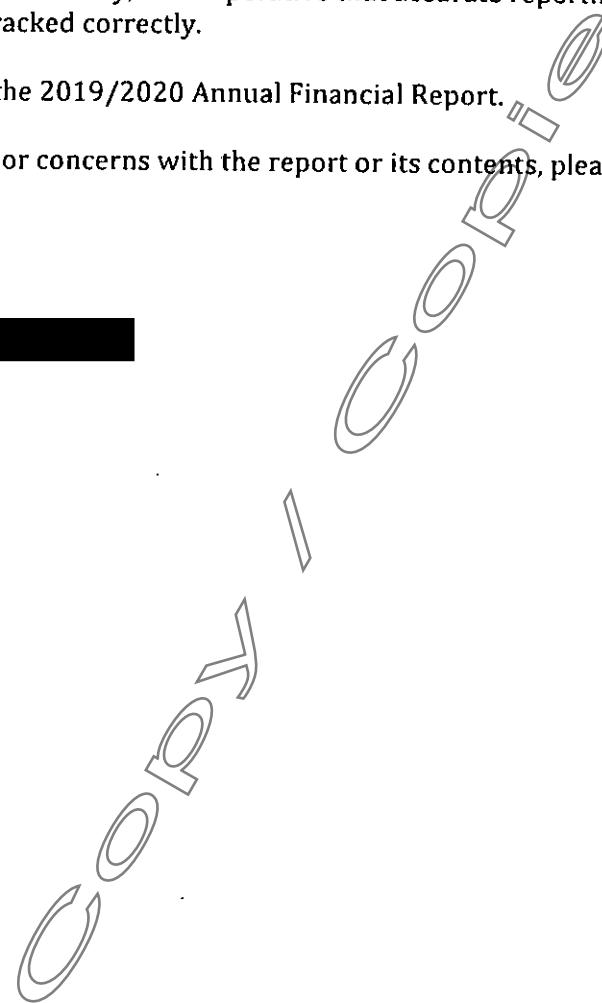

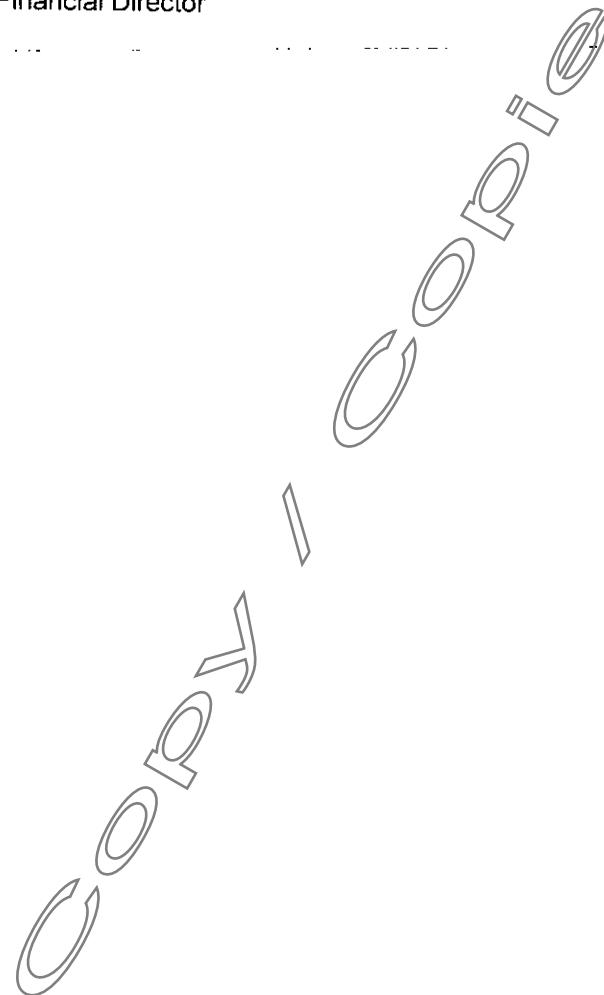

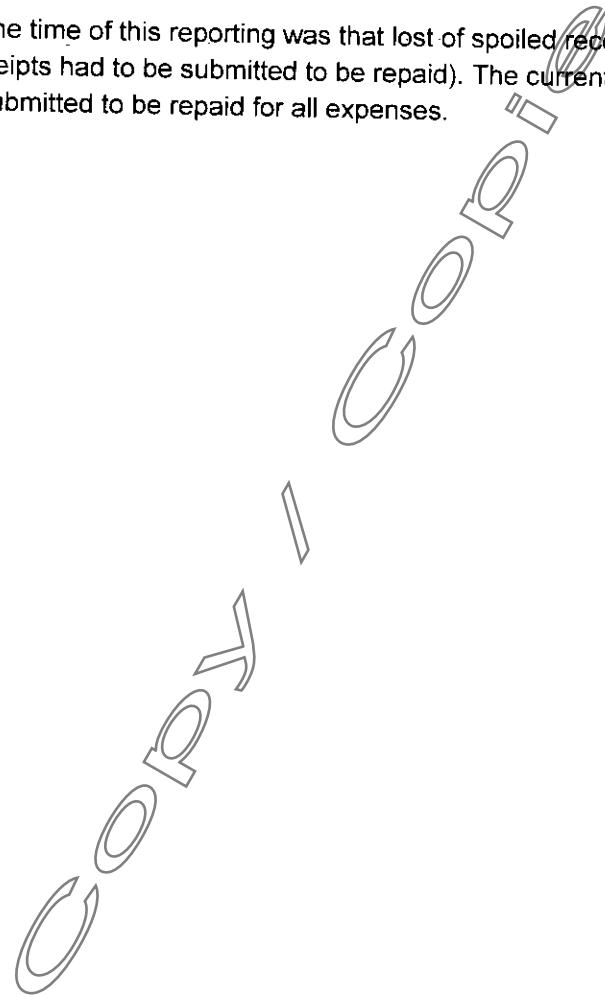
